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BIOGRAPHY

LTC Michael W. Griffith is a native of Tooele, Utah. He received a Field Artillery Commission in 1987 from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York. After completion of the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, LTC Griffith was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 10th Field Artillery (later redesignated as 5th Battalion, 41st Field Artillery), 3rd Infantry Division in Schweinfurt, Germany. He served as a Company Fire Support Officer, Platoon Fire Direction Officer, Platoon Leader, and Battalion Fire Support Officer. Upon graduation from the Field Artillery and the Armor Officer Advanced Courses in 1992, he was assigned to 1st Battalion, 41st Field Artillery "Glory's Guns" in Fort Stewart, Georgia. He served as Battalion S-1 and Alpha Battery Commander. During this time, LTC Griffith supported operations in Somalia, deployed to Kuwait in support of Operation Vigilant Warrior to deter Iraqi aggression, and deployed to Egypt in support of Operation Bright Star.

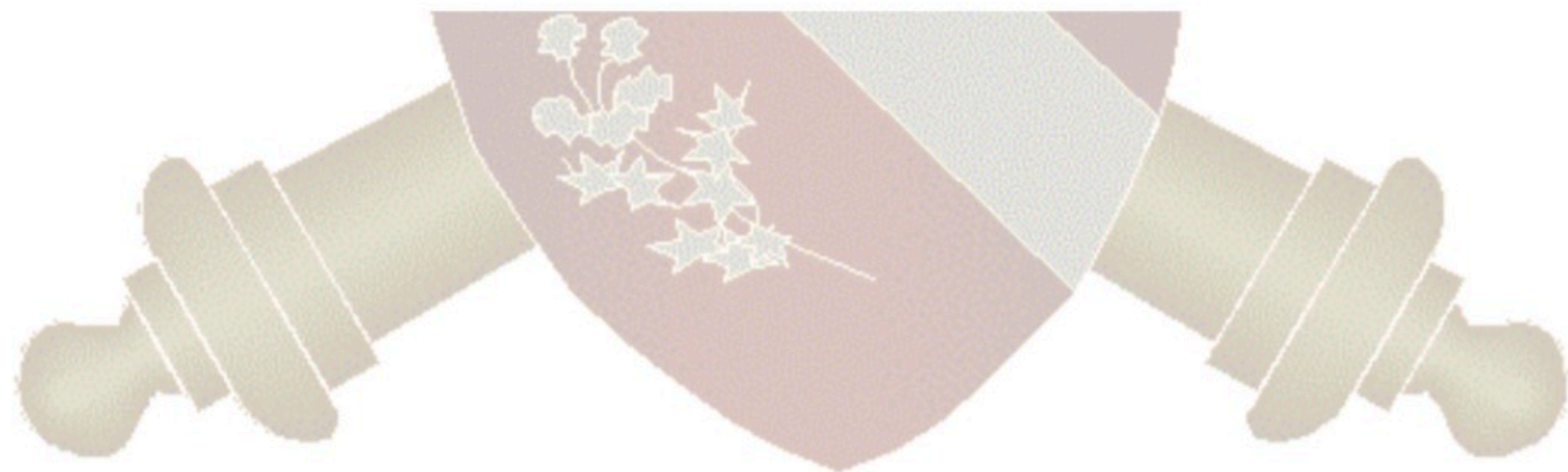
In 1996, LTC Griffith was assigned to the National Training Center, Fort Irwin, CA and served 26 rotations as the Alpha Battery Combat Trainer "Wolf 11." Upon completion of the Command and General Staff College, he was assigned to the Big Red One as S-3, 1st Battalion, 6th Field Artillery in Bamberg, Germany, in 1999. In this assignment, he deployed to Kosovo in support of peacekeeping operations. He later served as Plans Officer and Division Artillery S-3 prior to reassignment to Heidelberg, Germany in 2002. There, LTC Griffith served as Aide-de-Camp to the Command General, United States Army North Atlantic Treaty Organization for two and a half years. In this assignment, he deployed to Turkey and Northern Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, and supported operations in Afghanistan for Operation Enduring Freedom. Last summer, LTC Griffith rejoined the Big Red One in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and served as Special Assistant to the Assistant Division Commander for Maneuver.

LTC Griffith's awards include the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, the Army Achievement Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, the Southwest Asia Service Medal, the Kosovo Campaign Medal, the NATO Medal, and the Global War on Terrorism Service and Expeditionary Medals. LTC Griffith also wears the Joint Meritorious Unit Award, the Army Superior Unit Award, and the Parachutist Badge.
